



## Craft Information

The Tug Fest Committee of Illinois invites you to participate in our annual Great River Tug Fest on Friday & Saturday, August 13 & 14, 2010 in Port Byron, Illinois. This year promises to be very exciting from fireworks on Friday night to the Great River Tug on Saturday afternoon and entertainment throughout the weekend. For those who are interested, the booth fee is only \$50 per booth (12 x 12). The following outlines the information you will need:

**Date:** Friday August 13<sup>th</sup> and Saturday August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**Where:** Main Street, Port Byron, Illinois

**Friday Set-Up:** 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

**Saturday Set-Up:** 8:00 a.m. 9:00 a.m.

**Craft Fair:** Friday 3:00 p.m. to dusk

**Craft Fair:** 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

There will be electricity provided, if needed, for a \$20 fee per booth. We have 110 volt-20 amp service. It is the crafters responsibility to be G.F.I. protected and to have plugs to match our receptacles. Bring plenty of your own cords.

There will be minimal security provided from 11:00 p.m. on 13 Aug – 7:00 a.m. on 14 Aug. Please NO VEHICLES behind booths since there is no place to put them. NO REFUNDS will be given if vendor chooses to depart earlier than the end time.

**The Fee is \$50 for a 12X12 booth Extra \$20 for Electricity per booth.**

All crafters will be on a first come first service basis. Booths with electricity may be limited, so send applications in early. Pictures of craft items and/or display need to be sent with application. Confirmation of entry in craft fair will be sent by mail or email 2 weeks after received. If not approved, check will be returned.
